JOB TITLE: Part Time Academy Physiotherapist

REPORTING TO: Senior Academy Physiotherapist and Academy Manager

General Information

The Academy Physiotherapist must be hard working, committed, enthusiastic and willing to work hours that include a maximum of three evenings per week and at weekends on a rota basis as mutually arranged.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Hold the relevant qualifications as set out by the Football League Youth Development rules
- To assist with the treatment and rehabilitation of injuries programme of Academy players
- Work closely with senior staff to keep them informed of the progress and fitness of any Academy player.
- Support the Academy Sports Science Programme
- Maintain the player administration and attendance registers of players undergoing treatment in line with Elite Player Performance Plan (EPPP)
- Ensure they are up to date with all relevant FA Doping Rules and Regulations and report these to all relevant people within the Academy.
- Be prepared to enhance and develop their qualifications to meet the demands and needs of Oldham Athletic FC
- Maintain an appropriate communication network with the Club Doctor and relevant Specialists/Consultants in order to ensure players receive the relevant care, treatment and rehabilitation programmes to aid a full recovery from injury.
- Be responsible for having an up to date CRB check then subsequently maintain it.
- Attend Youth Team Games as second line Physio, if requested by the Academy's Senior Physio.
- The Physio must be presentable and professional in all aspects of their work and be aware that they are representatives of Oldham Athletic FC at all times.
